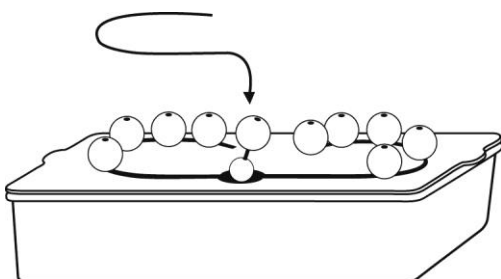


TASK 21 - BEAD SLIDE



Bead Slide is designed for students who have difficulty using their fingers in a coordinated manner or are easily distracted from attaining a designated goal. Grasping the bead, the student slides it along the track before pushing it into the “finished” opening.

If necessary, use hand-over-hand assistance to help the student be successful. Encourage the use of their right hand on the right side track and left hand on the left side track. For students who have difficulty crossing the midline, help them slide the beads on the opposite side of the hand in use.

Beads are arranged with the red beads exposed on the surface of the lid, five on each side of the track.

As always, adapt this ShoeboxTask to meet the specific needs of each student who uses it.

ASSEMBLY OF BEADS: Take a small cloth and wrap it around one end of the dowel screw. Screw the other end into the red bead, giving it about five good turns. Grasp the red bead and screw the remaining end into the plain, smaller bead, leaving about 1/4” space between beads. They're now ready for use.
