
TASK 29 - CLOSURE



Closure encourages the development of fine motor skills and the coordinated effort of using both hands. Students put one oversized Pom-pom into a container before cap is screwed on for closure.

When all four tubes are capped the activity is finished.

The student may want to put more than one pompom into a container. There is nothing wrong with this if the teacher has established this goal ahead of time. For example, the teacher may opt to leave only one tube in the Shoebox lid and encourage the student to put all 4 pompoms in it before capping it. It is important that students meet the predetermined goal, and not define it as they go along.

Closure can also be used in reverse by asking the student to first unscrew lids from tubes, remove pompoms, and place them in the 20 oz. container
