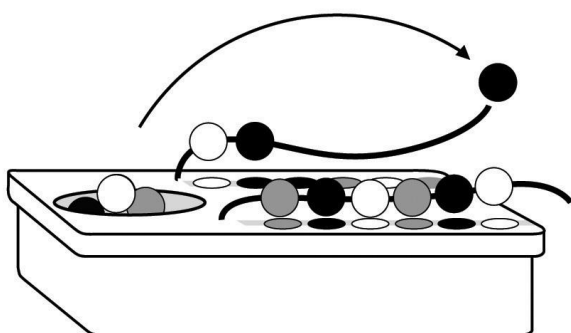


TASK 30 - BEAD PATTERNS



Coordinating the use of two hands, the student strings beads on either a pipe cleaner or shoelace while following a prescribed pattern of colored coins. The teacher places up to 6 colored coins on one or both of the Velcro strips. The order of color can be varied each time to ensure that the student is following the visual pattern that has been set up. The student matches the beads to the established pattern by placing them on the pipe cleaner.

The shoelaces increase the fine motor difficulty of the task.

NOTE: Use the two sets of guide holes to place and attach the 7" strips of Velcro to the lid.

CONTENTS:

- (1) Shoebox base
- (1) Shoebox lid
- (1) 20oz. container
- (12) velcroed coins, 3 colors
- (12) beads, 3 colors
- (2) pipe cleaners
- (2) shoelaces
- (2) 7" strips of velcro
