## TASK 33 - AROUND THE BLOCK



Up to 9 coins can be secured to the shoebox lid. Any combination of the three colors can be used. The same number of blocks are placed in the container. The student matches the color on the block to the colored disc on the lid. When joining the same colors on the lid (block to coin), the same color appears on the top. For students who may be new to matching, start with one, two or three coins, gradually increasing the number at a rate at which the student can be successful.

When installing the coins on the lid, make sure the Velcro meets the entire surface of each other, pressing down to give added strength to the bond.

This activity requires students to find the colors that match by turning the block. Besides encouraging fine motor control, the student must retain the goal of matching a particular color while looking for it on the block.

(1) Shoebox base
(1) Shoebox lid with 9 velcro coins attached
(1) 20oz. container
(9) blocks, each side velcroed 3 colors
(9) wood nickels, velcroed red opposite blue
(9) wood nickels, velcroed yellow opposite white
