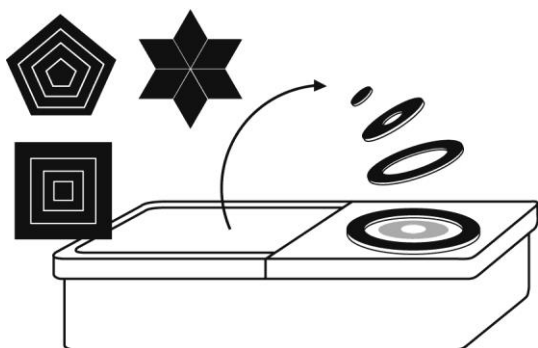


TASK 36 - BULLSEYE



The student matches geometric puzzle pieces to a pattern attached to the top half of the shoebox lid. *Bullseye* addresses organizational challenges that often characterize children with Autism. The one-unit presentation encourages independence and serves as a precursor to the more abstract folder tasks.

NOTE: Experiment by making additional patterns for matching using the array of puzzle pieces provided. If the student responds positively and independently to this structured activity, consider using a similar structure when presenting other puzzles or constructions (ie. Dox Blox, Tinker Toys, etc).

Install divider by pushing it against the Velcro coins along the inside of the base. Place a piece of putty on the underside and in the center of the lid to add stability.
